Chairman of SIAC Board

The Singapore International Arbitration Centre (SIAC) is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr Goh Joon Seng as a Director and Chairman of its Board of Directors. His term of appointment will take effect from 1 October 2004.

Mr Goh is a distinguished and respected figure in the legal community, having served as a Judge of the Supreme Court from 1990 – 2000. He is currently a consultant with the law firm of Lee & Lee.

He holds a number of concurrent positions including President of the Tribunal for the Maintenance of Parents; Member of the Presidential Council for Religious Harmony; Chairman of the Consumer Mediation Unit of the Association of Banks in Singapore; Chairman of the Insurance Disputes Resolution Organisation Limited; Member of the Permanent Court of Arbitration at the Hague; Member of the Appeal Advisory Panel under the Securities and Futures Act, the Financial Advisers Act and the Insurance Act; and Consultant to the Professional Indemnity Committee of the Law Society of Singapore, among many others.

Mr Goh will chair the SIAC Board, now comprising 10 distinguished members of the legal profession and industry to oversee the strategic directions of the SIAC, enabling it to undertake an enhanced role in the development of international arbitration in Singapore.
